

Club Affiliation Policy

Footgolf Association of Scotland is supportive of all aspects of development across Scotland, with a dedicated team to provide support to local clubs and courses.

Any club may apply for affiliation with the association, which will provide access to the support available and advertisement through the association channels.

Application For Affiliation

Any club may apply for FootGolf Association of Scotland Affiliation by submitting a completed application along with a copy of the club governing document (i.e. Constitution).

Upon receipt of the application, the association will review the constitution and get in contact to discuss with the contact person identified on the application the club set up and activities.

Club Structures

Affiliated clubs must have in place a committee responsible for the management of the club. The committee should be made up of no less than 3 members of the club and include a captain who will be the principle contact for taking part in any association activities as a club. *Please note that club members may take part in individual association activities without any communication with the club captain.*

Club Memberships

Membership of affiliated clubs must be open to any individual, with exception of exceptional circumstances.

What Will Not Be Accepted

The association intend to support all clubs to aid in their continued development, but intend on doing this responsibly.

All affiliation requests are considered on an individual basis, but there are a number of aspects which will not be accepted, which include but not limited to:

- Any club representing as a football club
- Any club using trademarked logos or branding, or resembling such logos or branding
- Any club considered to be in breach of association policies

Subscription Fees

FootGolf Association of Scotland may impose a subscription fee to the club which will be reinvested into the development of FootGolf in Scotland.

Subscription fees will be advised to the affiliated club in advance of any invoice, based on the number of members advised by the club in an annual audit of club memberships.

Failure to pay subscription fees will result in the affiliation (including access to any association activities and support) being ceased.
